# 772

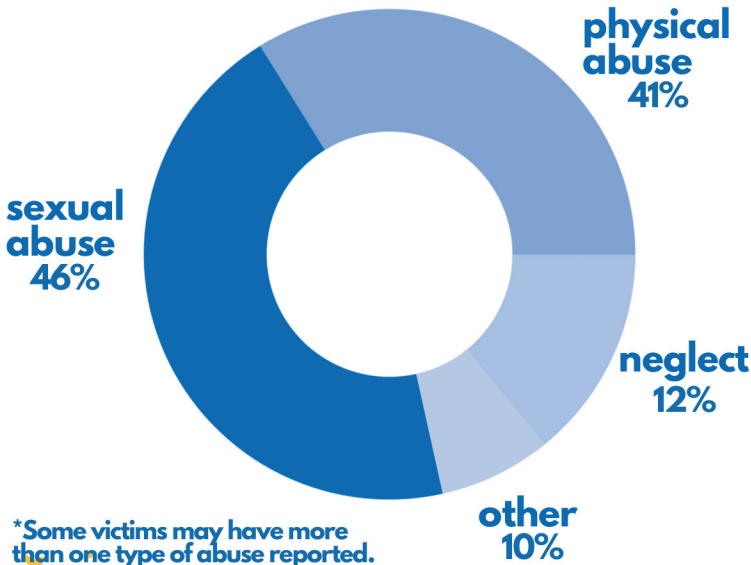
cases of reported child abuse were referred to the CAC (9% Military Dependents)

**56%** of the children seen were females  
**44%** of the children seen were males

**28%** were less than five years old

**96%** of the alleged offenders were known to the victim

## the impact of our mental health programs

**709** individual counseling appointments were attended

**105** children participated in counseling

**36** girl's group sessions were held and attended by 27 girls

**20** boy's group sessions were held and attended by 12 boys

**35** appointments with a therapy dog

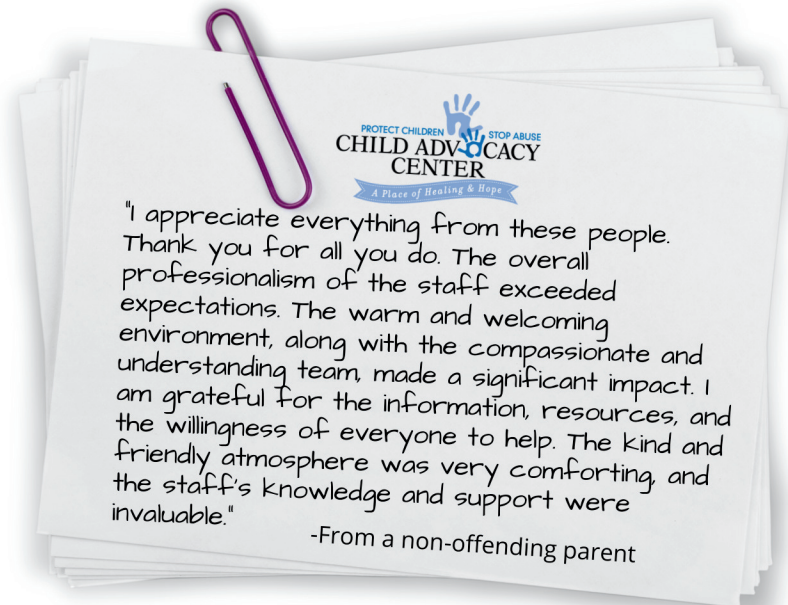
