THE RULES

- Acts with any group member under the age of 18 will perform in the matinee show. Acts with all group members 18 years or older will perform in the evening show.
- Group entry fees are due at the time the application is submitted. Only the first **12** groups for the matinee and **12** groups for the evening will be admitted to participate in the event.
- There is a maximum of 15 participants per group for the matinee show and 10 participants per group for the evening show.
- The maximum allowed time limit for your performance is 5 minutes.
- If more than one group chooses the same song, the song choice will be awarded on a first come, first serve basis.
- All songs, song lyrics, performances, and costumes must be in good taste.
- There can only be minimal stage prep for your act. Props can only consist of items that you can carry on stage and off stage. Prop microphones and microphone stands will be provided.
- All music must be turned in to the sound technician no later than Friday, May 2, 2025, two weeks prior to the rehearsal date. The sound technician will also be available for assistance with music cutting/editing prior to the due date (additional information will be provided upon registration).
- Acts performing at the matinee show must provide their own dedicated adult supervision backstage for the group members.
- Participants agree to allow the Child Advocacy Center to use any likeness, videos, or photographs taken during your performance for promotional use.
- **All acts are expected to participate in fundraising efforts prior to the event date.** There are multiple ways a group can fundraise including raffle tickets (provided by the Child Advocacy Center), acquiring donations, and/or acquiring sponsorships/vendors. On average, we hope that each group will raise approximately \$2,000, and pre-show fundraising is a part of your final score. Sponsorships are due by Friday, March 21, 2025. Remaining pre-show fundraising is due at the beginning of rehearsal on Friday, May 16, 2025.

THE DETAILS

- The date of the event is Saturday, May 17, 2025. The matinee begins at 1pm with performer check-in at 12pm. The evening show begins at 7pm with performer check-
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in at 6pm. Each show is expected to last approximately 2 ½ hours.

- The mandatory rehearsal is Friday, May 16, 2025. The matinee rehearsal begins at 5pm, and the evening show rehearsal begins at 7:30pm. Each rehearsal is expected to last 2 hours.
- The winning group from each show will receive \$500 CASH!
- The rehearsals and shows will take place at the Crown Center Ballroom located at 1960 Coliseum Drive, Fayetteville, NC 28306.
- Matinee show ticket prices are \$25.00 per ticket or \$40.00 for 2 tickets purchased together. The evening show prices are \$75.00 per ticket or \$140.00 for 2 tickets purchased together.
- Entry fee, raffle ticket, and donation checks should be made payable to “Child Advocacy Center”.
- This is a fundraising event where all proceeds will benefit the local Child Advocacy Center to support their services and mission.

HELPFUL HINTS

- Perform a song that is fun and upbeat. The best songs for lip sync are high-energy that allow for plenty of facial expressions and exaggerated movements.
- Costumes and props are strongly encouraged.
- Practice in front of people and ask for their feedback.
- Larger groups make fundraising easier and are crowd pleasers.
- Bring a cheering section of family and friends to the show, and **HAVE FUN!**

Judging Criteria & Scoring

Entry Fee: **Matinee—\$25.00; Evening—\$50.00**

Lip Sync Ability (score range: 1—10; awarded by each of the 4 judges)

The ability to mouth the words of a song in perfect synchronization with the recording, thereby creating the illusion that the person or group is performing the song on stage in concert.

Stage Presence & Creativity (score range: 1—10; awarded by each of the 4 judges)

The ability of performers to capture the attention of an audience and control that attention by being impressive in body language, charismatic behavior, general mannerisms, and the use of imagination and original ideas.

Choreography (score range: 1—10; awarded by each of the 4 judges)

Use of complex individual/synchronized movements as a group. Also use of movements that are compatible with the group song choice.

Costumes (score range: 1—10; awarded by each of the 4 judges)

Use of costumes and props and how well the costumes, hair styles, and accessories match the look of the original artist being recreated.

Crowd Appeal & Audience Response (score range: 1—10; awarded by each of the 4 judges)

Ability to engage the crowd and generate audience response. Don't just stand there...dance, smile, make eye contact, have fun... WOW the crowd!

Pre-Show Fundraising (score range: 1—10; awarded 1 time based on chart below)

The total amount raised by a group prior to the show divided by the number of group members determines your point value. For example, if you have 8 members in your group and the total money raised by your group is \$3,000, your average amount raised would be \$375, and your group would receive 3 points in the Pre-Show Fundraising category.

▪ Fundraising points will be awarded as follows:

Group Average: \$1--\$200	= 1 point	Group Average: \$601--\$700	= 6 points
Group Average: \$201--\$300	= 2 points	Group Average: \$701--\$800	= 7 points
Group Average: \$301--\$400	= 3 points	Group Average: \$801--\$900	= 8 points
Group Average: \$401--\$500	= 4 points	Group Average: \$901--\$1,000	= 9 points
Group Average: \$501--\$600	= 5 points	Group Average: \$1,001 & Above	= 10 points

At the Conclusion of the Event, Awards Will Be Given for the Following:

Top 3 (1st, 2nd, & 3rd Place) Pre-Show Fundraising

The three groups that raise the highest dollar amounts during pre-show fundraising regardless of the number of group members.

Best Costumes

The group (not in the top 3 for Fayetteville's Ultimate Lip Sync Stars) that scored the highest in the Costumes category.

Best Choreography

The group (not in the top 3 for Fayetteville's Ultimate Lip Sync Stars) that scored the highest in the Choreography category.

Best Stage Presence & Creativity

The group (not in the top 3 for Fayetteville's Ultimate Lip Sync Stars) that scored the highest in the Best Stage Presence & Creativity category.

Top 3 (1st, 2nd, & 3rd Place) People's Choice

The three groups that raise the highest dollar amounts during at-show fundraising regardless of the number of group members.

- At-Show Fundraising:

There will be a vote table set-up at the event where audience members can purchase votes by putting money into the individual groups' receptacles. The money will be counted at the conclusion of the event to determine the winners for People's Choice.

Top 3 (1st, 2nd, & 3rd Place) 2024 Fayetteville's Ultimate Lip Sync Stars

The three groups that accumulate the highest score totals (out of a maximum of 210) from the 6 main scoring categories (Lip Sync Ability, Stage Presence & Creativity, Choreography, Costumes, Crowd Appeal & Audience Response, and Pre-Show Fundraising). ***The winning group will be given a \$500 CASH prize!***

All decisions by the judges are final. The score of the Head Judge will be used to break any potential ties. In the rare occasion that a tie remains, the tie will be broken by using the point value for Pre-Show Fundraising.

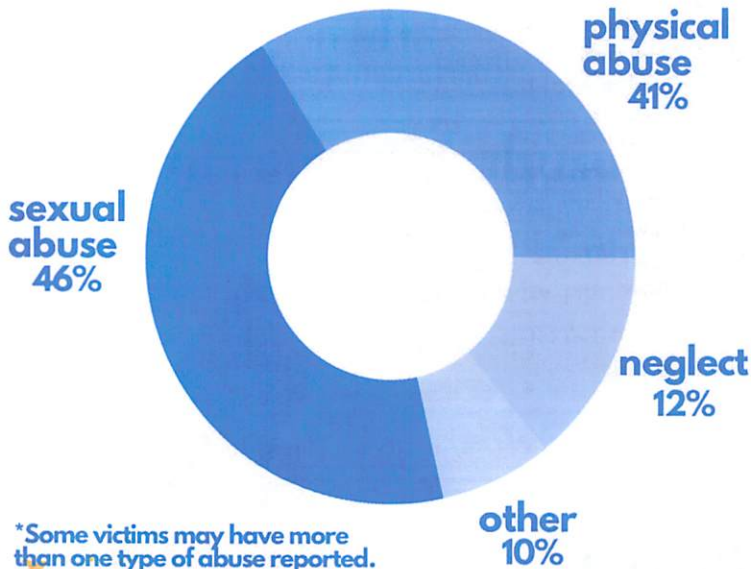
cases of reported child abuse were referred to the CAC (9% Military Dependents)

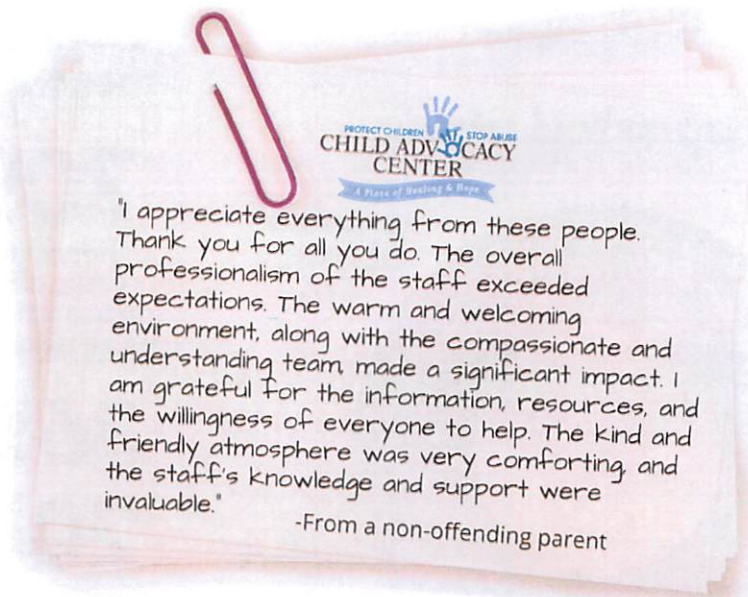
